### HEALTHCARE-FOCUSED ELECTIVE COURSES

Healthcare-focused electives must be chosen from the School of Medicine and Health Sciences (SMHS).

Elective examples:

- Medicines Development
- The Clinical Research Industry
- Health Information, Quality and Outcomes
- HCQ Analysis
- Patient Safety Systems
- Issues and Trends in Health Systems
- Epidemiology
- Introduction to Global Regulatory Affairs
- Regulatory Strategy in the Development of Drugs and Biologics

Students may petition to have up to 12 credits of GW graduate-level healthcare-focused courses outside of SMHS applied to their MBA healthcare-focused elective requirements. This maximum includes approved transfer credit (up to six credits), Consortium coursework and graduate-level courses completed at GW but outside the GWSB and SMHS.

The GW Healthcare MBA presents effective business and management strategies and applies them to healthcare environments, connecting these new concepts with your existing experience. The program is 46.5 credit hours and consists of 31.5 credit hours of core courses, 3 credits hours in technology selectives, with the remaining 12 credit hours reserved for healthcare-focused elective courses. Students have up to five years to complete all degree requirements.

# ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelor's degree from a college or university in the United States that is accredited by one of the six regional accrediting bodies. If you completed your degree outside the United States, it must be the equivalent of a four-year United States bachelor's degree. If you have any questions, please contact your advisor.
- At least two years of full-time, postundergraduate professional experience in the healthcare field is strongly preferred. However, GW does not have a minimum work experience requirement for admission.
- Applicants who have not completed a
  degree in a TOEFL exempt country must
  submit one of the following: an official
  TOEFL score of at least 100 (internet-based
  test) or 600 (paper-based test), or an official
  IELTS score of 7.0 with no individual band
  score below 6.0. Test date must be within
  the past two years. Scores are not required
  for U.S. citizens, U.S. permanent residents
  and U.S. board-certified physicians.

Your application will only be submitted for review through a member of the Admissions Team.

The completed application file must include:

- » A completed, submitted and signed online application form.
- » The application fee of \$80 USD payable online via credit card when submitting your application.
- » Official transcripts of all post-secondary academic programs attended.
- » A current resume or CV.
- » One (1) letter of recommendation demonstrating your professional experience and qualification for graduate study.
- » Statement of program objectives and professional goals.
